
Nature Journals

You can make your own simple journal!

- 1. Assemble a blank book from construction paper and blank paper as shown in the diagram.
- 2. Add a velcro fastener so that you can close the journal.



You can decorate your journal too!

- 1. Place a fresh (not dry) leaf upside down under a small square of cloth.
- 2. Tap the cloth gently with a hammer. An image of the leaf will appear on the cloth.
- 3. Use this natural picture to decorate the front of your journal.
