Kick Ash Cleanser ™

Put fire place ashes in a repurposed plastic container with holes punched in the lid.

To use, shake out on surface and scrub with a water dampened rag or use a damp sponge and dip into the ashes and scrub.

Rinse clean with water.

Use on stainless steel, porcelain, glass, fireplace doors and more.

Be sure to spot test first.



Tiny T-Shirt Hat Directions

Materials you will need: 1-2 T-Shirts and a pair of fabric scissors. Two colors are fun but not necessary.

Hat size depends on T-Shirt size. You will need to experiment with what works for your baby.

- 1. Cut off sleeve including seam on the sleeve.
- 2. Cut a narrow strip from the other T-Shirt. I used a strip about 2 inches by 12 inches.
- 3. Strip and sleeve cut and ready to go.
- 4. Stretch out the strip so that it curls into a tube shape.
- 5. Scrunch up the top edge of the sleeve to gather into a bunch.
- 6. Arrange the gather evenly and symmetrically.
- 7. Tie the strip TIGHTLY around the top just below the seam. Tie it again to form a square knot.
- 8. Tie half knots at either end of the strip to finish it off. Your hat is now ready to enjoy!
- 9. It makes a fun and unique shower gift. It works great for newborns and infants.
