

# Track Goop

This gooey mixture has all sort of uses from making temporary leaf prints to studying animal tracks. It's also just plain fun to play with!

## Goop Recipe Ingredients

- Water
- Elmer's glue \*
- Food color
- Borax laundry booster (20 mule team)
- 2 bowls
- mixing spoon

### Solution A:

- 1 cup water
- 1 cup Elmer's glue = 1 7.625 ounce bottle
- 7-8 drops of food color

Mix all of these ingredients into a bowl.

### Solution B:

- 1 1/3 cup warm water
- 4 teaspoons borax laundry booster (20 mule team)

Mix ingredients of this solution in a bowl until completely dissolved.

1. Slowly pour **Solution A** into **Solution B. DO NOT MIX!**
2. Roll solution around in bowl 4 – 6 times.
3. Lift the semi-solid solution out and knead it for a few minutes.
4. Divide a small portion for each child to use with the rubber tracks.

This solution can be re-used when stored in a sealed Ziplock bag.

\* Do not use any other kind of glue except Elmer's as other brands of glue do not tend to work as well.
