

"Egyptian Pyramids" – July 1

The team travels to Egypt to scan the pyramids to find out how the necropolis evolved from simple mud-brick structures to the most impressive buildings in the ancient world. They use their cutting-edge laser technology to scan Djoser's Step Pyramid at Saqqara, Meidum's collapsed pyramid, the mysterious Bent Pyramid at Dahshur and the famous Great Pyramid at Giza.

"St. Paul's Cathedral" – July 8

"Who Killed Jimmy Hoffa?" – July 22

Former Teamsters president Jimmy Hoffa went missing on July 30, 1975, never to be found. Hoffa, a hero to many working Americans, played a major role in the growth and development of the trucking union. But he fell afoul of the law, with allegations that the powerful pension fund was under mob control and used, among other things, to finance Vegas casinos.




