## ON THE COVER

*The Roosevelts: An Intimate History* chronicles the lives of Theodore, Franklin, and Eleanor Roosevelt, three members of the most prominent and influential family in American politics. It is the first time in a major documentary television series that their individual stories have been interwoven into a single narrative.

This 7-part, 14-hour film follows the Roosevelts for more than a century, from Theodore's birth in 1858 to Eleanor's death in 1962. Over the course of those years, Theodore would become the 26th President of the United States and his beloved niece, Eleanor, would marry his fifth cousin, Franklin, who became the 32nd President of the United States. Together, these three individuals not only redefined the relationship

Americans had with their government and with each other, but also redefined the role of the United States within the wider world.

The series encompasses the history the Roosevelts helped to shape: the creation of National Parks, the digging of the Panama Canal, the passage of innovative New Deal programs, the defeat of Hitler, and the postwar struggles for civil rights at home and human rights abroad. It is also an intimate human story about love, betrayal, family loyalty, personal courage, and the conquest of fear.

*The Roosevelts: An Intimate History* airs every day at 8pm September 14-20 with repeats immediately following at 10pm on 34.1 and 34.2.

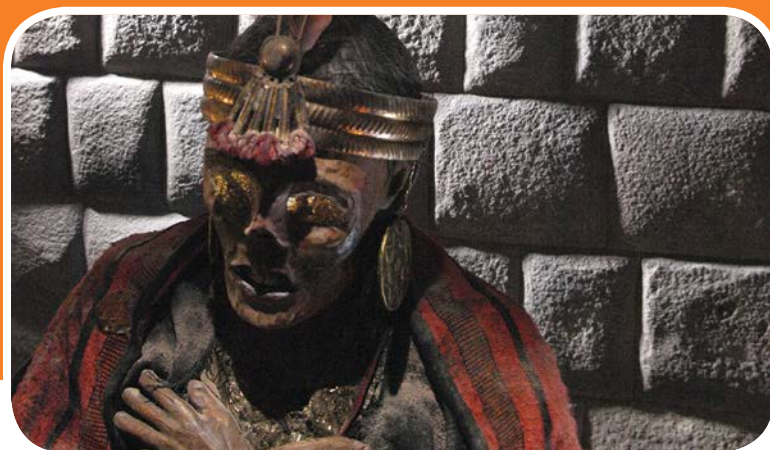

### **CUBAN MISSILE CRISIS: THREE MEN GO TO WAR** TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 2, 8PM

Explore the inside story of the Cuban Missile Crisis in October 1962, when the world teetered on the brink of nuclear holocaust. Premiering on the 50th anniversary of the missile crisis, CUBAN MISSILE CRISIS: THREE MEN GO TO WAR focuses on three central figures in the crisis — President John F. Kennedy, Soviet Premier Nikita Khrushchev and Cuban leader Fidel Castro.

ROOSEVELTS: AN INTIMATE HISTORY weaves the stories of Theodore, Franklin and Eleanor Roosevelt, three members of one of the most prominent and influential families in American politics. The 14-hour series marks the first time their individual stories have been woven into a single narrative.

**"GET ACTION (1858-1901)" –**  
**SEPTEMBER 14**

A frail, asthmatic young Theodore Roosevelt transforms himself into a champion of the strenuous life, leads men into battle and then rises like a rocket to become the

youngest president in American history at 42. Meanwhile, Franklin Delano Roosevelt, follows his older cousin's career with worshipful fascination and begins to think he might one day follow in his footsteps.

**"IN THE ARENA (1901-1910)" –**  
**SEPTEMBER 15**

Murder brings Theodore Roosevelt to the presidency, but in the seven years that follow, he transforms the office and makes himself perhaps the best-loved of all the men who ever lived in the White House. FDR courts and weds Eleanor Roosevelt.

**"THE FIRE OF LIFE (1910-1919)" –**  
**SEPTEMBER 16**

Theodore Roosevelt leads a Progressive crusade that splits his own party. Franklin masters wartime Washington as Assistant Secretary of the Navy, while Eleanor finds personal salvation in war work.

**"THE STORM (1920-1933)" –**  
**SEPTEMBER 17**

Franklin Roosevelt runs for vice president in 1920 and seems assured of a still brighter future until polio devastates him the following summer. Eleanor builds a personal and political life of her own. FDR returns to politics in 1928 and, as governor of New York, acts with such vigor and imagination during the first years of the Great Depression that the Democrats turn to him as their presidential nominee in 1932.

## “THE RISING ROAD (1933-1939)” – SEPTEMBER 18

Aimed at ending the Depression, FDR's sweeping New Deal restores the people's self-confidence and transforms the relationship between them and their government. Eleanor rejects the traditional role of first lady, becomes her husband's liberal conscience and a sometimes controversial political force in her own right.

## “THE COMMON CAUSE (1939-1944)” – SEPTEMBER 19

FDR shatters the third-term tradition, struggles to prepare a reluctant country to enter World War II and, after the Japanese attack on Pearl Harbor, helps set the course toward Allied victory. Meanwhile, Eleanor struggles to keep New Deal reforms alive in wartime and travels the Pacific to comfort wounded servicemen.

## “A STRONG AND ACTIVE FAITH (1944-1962)” – SEPTEMBER 20

Frail and failing but determined to see the war through to victory, FDR wins re-election, but a cerebral hemorrhage kills him at 63. After her husband's death, Eleanor Roosevelt proves herself a shrewd politician and a skilled negotiator.

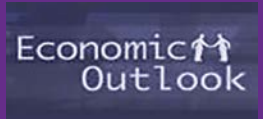

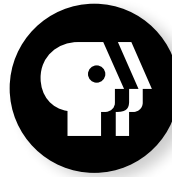

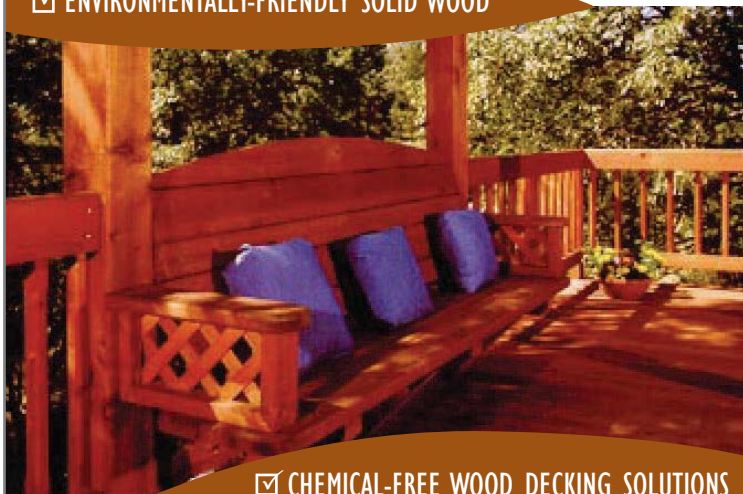

# SUPPORTER SPOTLIGHT

JAMES R. HARDESTY



WNIT shines the Supporter Spotlight on the late James R. Hardesty of Hamlet, Indiana. James passed away in June of 2014 at the Catherine Kasper Life Center in Donaldson, Indiana.

James was a passionate viewer of WNIT and a sustained Directors' Circle member. He comprised a dedicated group of WNIT supporters from the Marshall County region and was almost like family in his support, critique and pride in WNIT. James also played a critical role in the interview process of World War II veterans who shared their war time experiences on camera for WNIT.

He graduated from Hamlet High school in 1939, Purdue University in 1942 and served as a sergeant in the U.S. Army during the European Theatre in World War II. James was also a lifelong farmer on the 1895 Hardesty Family Farm. Awards received by James Hardesty during his lifetime included the Henry F. Schricker Service Award and the Honorary Doctor of Humane Letters from Ancilla College.
