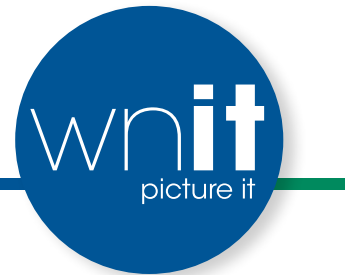
## Region loses great leader with the passing of Bob Bartels
