*Chamaecrista fasciculata* - Partridge Pea  
*Coreopsis lanceolata* - Sand Coreopsis  
*Desmanthus illinoensis* - Illinois Bundle Flower  
*Echinacea purpurea* - Purple Coneflower  
*Elymus canadensis* - Canada Wild Rye  
*Eryngium yuccifolium* - Rattlesnake Master  
*Heliopsis helianthoides* - False Sunflower  
*Lespedeza capitata* - Round-headed Bush Clover  
*Liatris pycnostachya* - Prairie Blazing Star  
*Lupinus perennis* - Wild Lupine  
*Monarda fistulosa* - Wild Bergamot  
*Parthenium integrifolium* - Wild Quinine  
*Penstemon digitalis* - Foxglove Beardtongue  
*Pycnanthemum virginianum* - Virginia Mountain Mint  
*Petalostemum purpureum* - Purple Prairie Clover  
*Ratibida pinnata* - Gray Coneflower R  
*Rudbeckia hirta* - Black-eyed Susan  
*Silphium integrifolium* - Rosin Weed  
*Silphium laciniatum* - Compass Plant  
*Silphium terebinthinaceum* - Prairie Dock  
*Schizachyrium scoparium* - Little Bluestem Grass  
*Sorghastrum nutans* - Indian Grass
