And you did, and more! All together, you contributed \$35,865. With the matching funds, we were able to raise \$50,865 from 140 donors. Thank you! Your support helps keep the great programming we provide, without commercial interruption, on both of WNIT’s channels, 34.1 and 34.2.

It always seems I have too much information to share in too short a letter, and this issue of the *Planner* is no exception! We start with the program that draws WNIT’s largest audience of the year, *A Capital Fourth*, on July 4th of course, will start at 8pm, with a repeat at 9:30.
