A MESSAGE FROM GREG GICZI President and GM, WNIT Public Television



Dear WNIT Heroes,

You're a hero to me because it's your support that makes WNIT happen. We are community owned, "WNIT belongs to me!" It's the gifts we receive from you and local businesses / organizations that fund the \$10,000 per day it takes to operate *your* Michiana PBS television station, WNIT. Thank you.

I've been waiting a long time for this issue of the *WNIT Planner* magazine. It's the one in which I get to announce that the *PBS Kids Channel on WNIT* will officially launch on Monday, June 24. I consider this the single most important mission-related WNIT accomplishment since our founders established Michiana Public Broadcasting Corporation in 1968. Our new channel, our third, will appear as 34.3 if you watch via an antenna or on a new channel (Ch. 1159 on Comcast) on your cable system. The satellite TV systems have opted not to carry the new channel.

The *PBS Kids Channel on WNIT* will operate 7 days a week, 24 hours a day, to provide commercial-free, entertainingly educational early-learning programming for young children. It will be a great "anytime" supplement to a child's pre-school program or a way to give a child solid early-learning opportunities if they are unable to attend a pre-school. This new service will not only be a free broadcast service, but available for streaming to a mobile device, such as a smart phone or tablet.

The *PBS Kids Channel on WNIT* is made possible by a small group of donors who recognize the importance of early childhood education and WNIT's role in delivering it, free of charge, to everyone. You will find these wonderful people and organizations listed inside this *WNIT Planner* magazine. We are still slightly short of our goal, but I know we are going to end up exceeding it! Let's hear from you north Berrien, Fulton, LaGrange, Pulaski, and Starke county donors.

I have an interesting story to share. A few weeks ago, I experienced a medical "glitch" and was sent to the Emergency Room. There, I was treated by an ER doctor who recognized me from my picture in the *WNIT Planner* magazine. Dr. "W" is a sustaining member of WNIT! Naturally, I did spend a few moments trying to coax her to increase her monthly donation. You meet great WNIT viewers everywhere!

As always, lots of great programming coming up. Sundays in May at 6pm, WNIT will encore some of our favorite *Our Town* documentaries. These programs have been viewer favorites.

Mondays in May at 10pm, WNIT will feature *Stories of Service* as we remember all who have served our country. We'll end the month with PBS's annual *National Memorial Day Concert*, on Sunday, May 26th, at 8pm and repeated at 9:30pm.




