Enjoy your last days of summer and when that last BBQ is over, settle in for a fabulous fall of great programming from PBS and WNIT. Years in the making, *Country Music* by Ken Burns is the story of America's history and culture. I have been totally captivated by the previews I've seen. The 16 hours of Ken Burns' *Country Music* will be broadcast on WNIT Sunday through Wednesday, 8pm-10pm, September 15<sup>th</sup> through September 25<sup>th</sup>. Our local *Legends of Michiana* documentary series returns Thursday, September 26<sup>th</sup> at 8pm when we recognize Southwestern Michigan's Pat Moody. I hope you've noticed that your WNIT pictures have improved. Upgrades that were needed to add the *PBS Kids Channel* also benefited some other aspects of our operations. I won't bore you with the technical mumbo-jumbo, but take my word for it, your WNIT signal is better than ever.

Speaking of technology, WNIT and most other local stations will be doing some Federal Communications Commission mandated shifting of channels. This will all happen around 2am on Friday, October 18<sup>th</sup>. If you have a cable or satellite service, the change will be transparent to you. If you watch off of an antenna the good old fashioned way, you will simply need to rescan your channels first thing Friday morning when you get up. As we get closer to October 18<sup>th</sup>, all local stations will be providing information and support.

## Ken Burns' Newest Documentary, "Country Music" to Air on WNIT Public Television!

Explore the history of a uniquely American art form: country music. From its deep and tangled roots in ballads, blues and hymns performed in small settings, to its worldwide popularity, learn how country music evolved over the course of the twentieth century. The series, directed by Ken Burns, features never-before-seen footage and photographs, plus interviews with more than 80 country music artists. No one has told the story this way before.

Directed and produced by Burns and written and produced by Burns's longtime producing partner Dayton Duncan, **COUNTRY MUSIC** will chronicle the history of a uniquely American art form, rising from the experiences of remarkable people in distinctive regions of our nation. From southern Appalachia's songs of struggle, heartbreak and faith to the rollicking western swing of Texas, from California honky tonks to Nashville's Grand Ole Opry, the series will follow the evolution of country music over the course of the 20<sup>th</sup> century, as it eventually emerged to become America's music.

Duncan and Burns spent eight years researching and producing the film, conducting interviews with more than 100 people, including 40 members of the Country Music Hall of Fame (17 of those interviewed have since passed on). Among those storytellers are historian Bill Malone and a wide range of country artists such as Marty Stuart, Rosanne Cash, Vince Gill, Reba McEntire, Merle Haggard, Dolly Parton, Willie Nelson, Dwight Yoakam, Emmylou Harris, Kris Kristofferson, and Naomi and Wynonna Judd, as well as studio musicians, record producers and others. The film uses more than 3,200 photographs and over two hours of archival footage, including rare and never-before-seen photos and footage of Jimmie Rodgers, Johnny Cash and others.

"At the heart of every great country music song is a story," said Ken Burns. "As the songwriter Harlan Howard said, 'It's three chords and the truth.' The common experiences and human emotions speak to each of us about love and loss, about hard times and the chance of

redemption. As an art form, country music is also forever revisiting its history, sharing and updating old classics and celebrating its roots, which are, in many ways, foundational to our country itself."

"We discovered that country music isn't—and never was—*one* type of music; it actually is many styles," said Dayton Duncan. "It sprang from diverse roots, and it sprouted many branches. What unites them all is the way the music connects personal stories and elemental experiences with universal themes that every person can relate to. And as it evolved, from the bottom up, it created a special bond between the artists and fans that is unique among all other musical genres."


