President and GM, WNIT Public Television

You make our community-owned public television station possible. It was just a few weeks ago that WNIT celebrated the start of its 46th year of broadcasting. It is so encouraging and amazing to know that for all those years WNIT has been able to operate and grow because you value what we do enough to send in your contribution each year. I can't express enough how much that is appreciated. Say to yourself with pride, "WNIT belongs to me!" Thank you.

We're starting March off with our most important membership drive of the year. Running through March 15th, we'll have special programs which showcase the breadth of programming found on WNIT. One program that we know many are looking forward to watching is financial guru Suze Orman's new "Ultimate Retirement Guide." It's never too early or too late to pick up some tips to keep you financially secure.

As I attend various community meetings across the WNIT coverage area, a common concern I hear is the need for affordable housing. But sometimes our solutions create bad results. This April, we will bring you the story of Octave Chanute, a Chicago aeronautic design pioneer whose wing design, tested at the Indiana Dunes, was used by the Wright brothers. I love these stories!

WNIT has been the beneficiary of two recent bequests. We miss those viewers but are grateful for the gifts. They often come with a message that expresses how important WNIT was in the person's life as a companion and source of lifelong learning. Thank you to all of you who continue to remember us as part of your legacy.
