Let the election season begin! We'll start it off with Independence Day fireworks on *A Capitol Fourth,* Saturday, July 4th, at 8pm and repeated at 9:30pm, on WNIT, Channel 34.1. As we progress to the August conventions, look for *American Experience* episodes about Bill Clinton (Tuesdays July 21 and 28 at 8pm) and Ronald Reagan (Tuesdays August 4 and 11 at 8pm). PBS NewsHour will provide coverage of both conventions later in August.

I hope you are discovering WNIT's 34.2 channel. Public television has such a wealth of great programs, one channel isn't enough. You will find many programs not shown on our primary channel, 34.1.

This August marks the 100th anniversary of women securing the right to vote, passage of the 19th Amendment. WNIT channel 34.2 will feature programs on August 17th, 19th and 24th featuring women who were champions of women's rights.

Give yourself a break from the virus and national politics with the 7th season of *Endeavour* which premieres Sunday, August 9th, 9pm on channel 34.1.

We are excited to be one of the first stations to bring you the regional production, *Octave Chanute: Patron Saint of Flight.* Chanute was a Chicago engineer who collaborated and competed with the Wright brothers. He tested his wing designs in the Indiana Dunes. This is a great bit of regional history. The producer, Paul Nelson, let me preview his film some months ago before final completion. I immediately said, "Sign us up!"

During the summer, WNIT continues providing supplemental at-home learning materials for students with programs tied to online support, deepening the teaching experience. Stop the "summer slump!"



The Vote: American Experience to Air on WNIT July 6-7

AMERICAN EXPERIENCE The Vote, a new four-hour, two-part documentary series, tells the dramatic story of the epic — and surprisingly unfamiliar — crusade waged by American women for the right to vote. Focusing primarily on the movement's final decade, the film charts American women's determined march to the ballot box, and illuminates the myriad social, political and cultural obstacles that stood in their path. *The Vote* delves into the controversies that divided the nation in the early 20th century — gender, race, state's rights, and political power — and reveals the fractious dynamics of social change. *The Vote* premieres Monday and Tuesday, July 6-7, 2020, 9:00-11:00 p.m. ET on WNIT, PBS.org and the PBS Video App.

The documentary is part of the PBS Trailblazers summer programming lineup honoring the 100th anniversary of the passage of the 19th Amendment of women's suffrage. The series is narrated by Kate Burton and features the voices of the unsung warriors of the movement: Mae Whitman (Alice Paul), Audra McDonald (Ida B. Wells), Laura Linney (Carrie Chapman Catt) and Patricia Clarkson (Harriot Stanton Blatch).

"The hard-fought campaign waged by American women for the right to vote was a truly transformative cultural and political movement, resulting in the largest expansion of voting rights in American history," said executive producer Susan Bellows. "It's also a story that has usually been reduced to a single page in the history books. *The Vote* restores this complex story to its rightful place in our history, providing a rich and clear-eyed look at a movement that resonates as much now as ever."





American Experience to Present Documentaries on Presidents Clinton and Reagan!

From draft dodging to the Dayton Accords, from Monica Lewinsky to a balanced budget, the presidency of William Jefferson Clinton veered between sordid scandal and grand achievement. In Clinton, AMERICAN EXPERIENCE explores the fascinating story of an American president who rose from a turbulent childhood in Arkansas to become one of the most successful politicians in modern American history and one of the most complex and conflicted characters ever to stride across the public stage. It recounts a career full of accomplishment and rife with scandal, a marriage that would make history and create controversy, and a presidency that would define the crucial and transformative period between the fall of the Berlin Wall and 9/11. It follows Clinton across his two terms as he confronted some of the key forces that would shape the future. Most memorably, it explores how Clinton's conflicted character made history, even as it enraged his enemies and confounded his friends. From Emmy and Peabody Award-winning director Barak Goodman (My Lai), the fourhour Clinton will premiere on WNIT on consecutive Tuesdays, July 21 & 28 at 8pm.



Reagan, a four-hour, two-part biography of the president who saw America as "a shining city on a hill" will have an encore broadcast Tuesday and Wednesday, August 15-16 at 9p.m. on WNIT. This documentary examines Reagan's life through the testimony of family — including Nancy Reagan and three of his children — along with friends, historians, biographers, and other witnesses to Reagan's private life and public career.

Ronald Reagan was America's most ideological president in his rhetoric, yet pragmatic in his actions. He believed in balanced budgets, but never submitted one; hated nuclear weapons, but built them by the thousands; preached family values but presided over a dysfunctional family. His vision of America divided the nation, yet no matter what people thought of him politically, Reagan always won them over personally. "People don't reckon with the power of charm," says son Ron Reagan. "When my father turns the high beams on, even somebody like Gorbachev tends to melt." A seemingly simple man, Ronald Reagan was consistently underestimated by his opponents; one by one, he overcame them all.


