

A Message from Greg Giczi President and GM, PBS Michiana - WNIT

Hello Friends of PBS Michiana - WNIT!

I'm feeling very upbeat these days! It's now light when I travel to and from work...it's not as cold on my nightly "dog walks."...I know people who have actually received the COVID-19 vaccine... and, in general, people are smiling more and seem to be more optimistic. I hope that you're feeling the same way.

Do you like our new PBS Michiana – WNIT logo design? It emphasizes our PBS affiliation and speaks to serving our whole Michiana region. I've been in the television broadcast industry a long time, so I will always think in terms of "call letters" like W-N-I-T. A few years ago, we only had one channel of programming but today we have three and more on the way. You will see that we identify our "primary" channel as simply PBS Michiana – WNIT. For our other programming channels, we add a number, PBS Michiana – WNIT2, PBS Kids Michiana – WNIT3. In this way, we hope to develop a system of program channel identifications that are easy to follow as we grow. If you view using an antenna, you'll find our channels of programming at 34.1, 34.2, and 34.3. For cable or satellite, our channels are usually scattered. We provide a guide in each *Planner* magazine to help you find them.

PBS Michiana – WNIT's March and April programming is matching stride with the fantastic January and February line-up of PBS shows. I'm still hearing lots of positive comments about *All Creatures Great and Small* and *The Black Church* (I'm still singing along). I hope you also saw the two local special programs we produced to add some local/regional history to the national *The Black Church* story.

Your PBS Michiana – WNIT Planner magazine is again loaded with program descriptions and recommendations, but I always like to suggest a few of my favorites...

Women in Leadership is a new local program which premieres March 4th. Every three months we will highlight a profession and three exceptional women at her beginning, mid-level, and senior levels. Thanks to member, and WNIT founder, Jerry Hammes who encouraged us to produce this series! On March 26th, the Elkhart County Symphony Orchestra shares a performance for all of Michiana. On April 5-6-7, Ken Burns' awaited Hemingway will be presented. I've been looking forward to this since I first spotted it in the PBS production "pipeline." And, on April 13th, *Frontline* presents "American Insurrection." That will be a very unsettling but important program to watch.




