I hope this first part of summer is going well for you. Being fully vaccinated, I'm enjoying opportunities to socialize, but I'm still being cautious. I plan to take some time off this summer, sure looking forward to it!

PBS Michiana - WNIT is declaring this summer one to "Celebrate the St. Joe." On September 9th, we will premiere the documentary *Then, Now and Always...The St. Joseph River Story*. To lead up to the premiere, communities from the headwaters (Hillsdale County, MI) to Lake Michigan are going to be recognizing the importance of the St. Joseph River to our region. There will be festivals, art exhibits, museum exhibits, special events at libraries and other creative expressions of our love of the St. Joe.

Sunday, July 4th, PBS brings its annual "A Capitol Fourth" at 8pm and repeating at 9:30pm. The following Sunday night, July 11th, both *Unforgotten* Season 4 and *Professor T* (UK version) will premiere.


For music fans, a very interesting summer series starts Friday, July 16th at 9pm. I'm not quite sure how to describe *Icon: Music Through the Lens*. I'm not going to try...watch the first episode and see if you enjoy it!

Looking to August, several shows caught my personal attention. Frontline will recognize the 20th anniversary of "9/11" with two documentaries. On Tuesday, August 10th, at 9pm, PBS Michiana - WNIT will present *Frontline: In the Shadow of 9/11*. Then on Tuesday, August 31st at 9pm, *Frontline: Generation 9/11* is presented. Another program on my list is *Unforgivable Blackness: The Rise and Fall of Jack Johnson*. This is the story of the first African-American heavyweight champion. This two-part documentary starts Monday, August 30th.

PBS Michiana - WNIT will have its August membership drive beginning the 14th of the month. One of the BIG special programs we will feature is a newly produced concert version of the hit Broadway musical, *Wicked*. Mark your calendars for Sunday, August 29th, at 9pm.

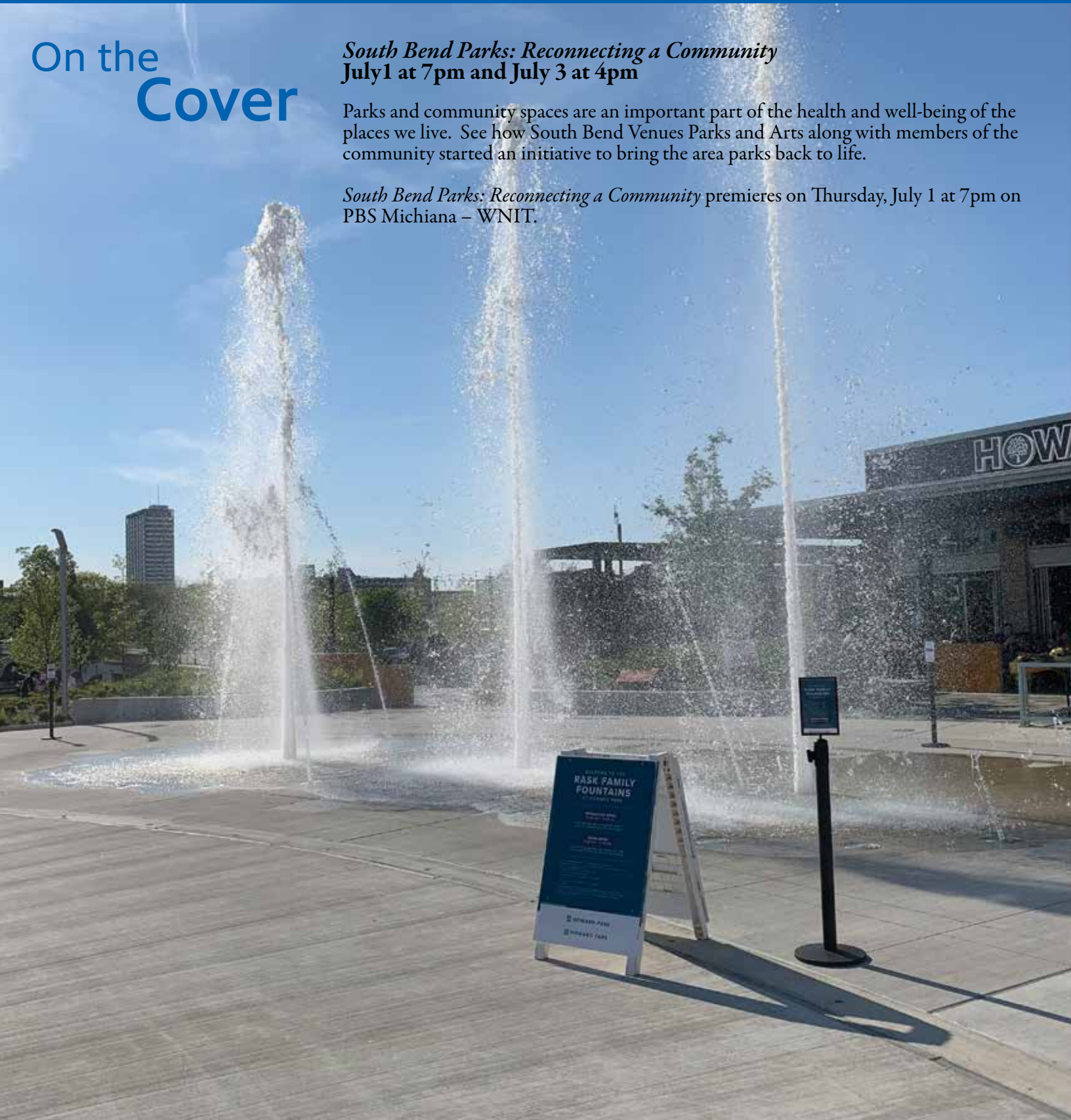

PBS MICHIANA - WNIT has joined the other public television stations serving Michigan communities in airing the Michigan Learning Channel (MLC), which was launched this year to deliver instructional content and programming to students, parents and teachers, developed in partnership with leading educators and community leaders.

Each public television station has created its own dedicated channel for the MLC. In the WNIT viewing area, it is broadcast on channel 34.5, which began June 1, 2021. It is also available at MichiganLearning.org as a livestream as well as posted for on-demand viewing on a variety of digital and social media platforms, including cell phones and other mobile devices.

The Michigan Learning Channel replaces the temporary At-Home-Learning channel, which WNIT had been broadcasting on channel 34.5 since the beginning of the pandemic. The At-Home-Learning channel was a temporary partnership between the WORLD Channel, PBS Learning Media and WNIT.

The Michigan Learning Channel seeks to ensure accessibility to all students, educators and families. The programming schedule is made available to teachers and school administrators to explore possible integration with lesson plans and can be viewed at MichiganLearning.org/schedule or at wnit.org/athomelearning.

“We are pleased to announce our partnering with the Michigan Learning Channel. It has been developed in collaboration with leading people in the field of education and with a diverse cross-section of parents and concerned citizens to meet the evolving needs of families and teachers,” said WNIT President and General Manager Greg Giczi. “Public television has a long history of developing age-appropriate educational content in partnership with those closest to the communities we serve.”

“Whether our viewers are in Southwest Michigan or Indiana, they will find the MLC an invaluable resource for the education of students. It uses all platforms at our disposal – over the air, online and through social media – to increase access to educational programming and resources, at home, schools, daycare centers or wherever students may be.”

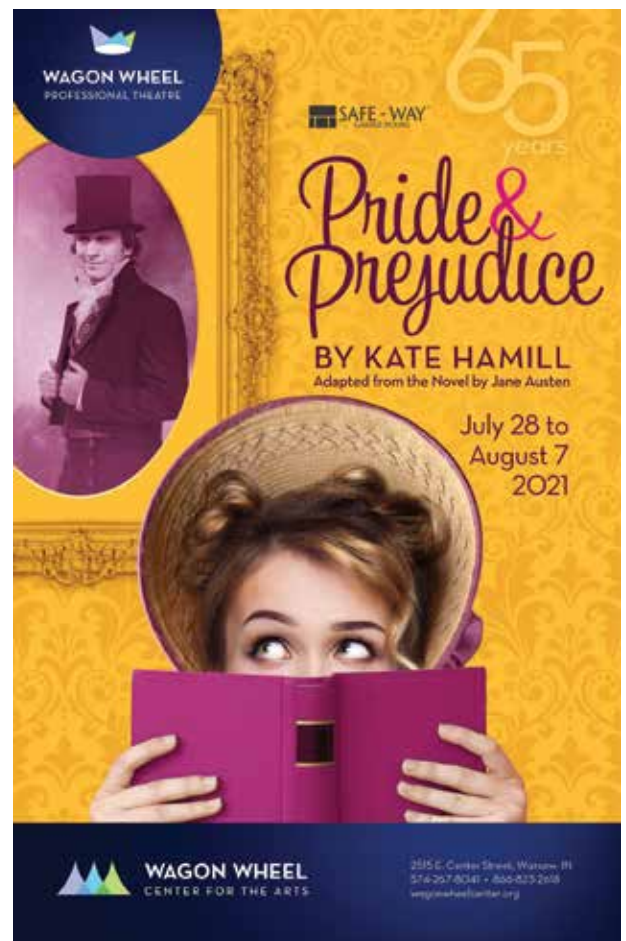

Then, Now and Always...The St. Joseph River Story Highlights Celebrate the St. Joe Summer Activities

Throughout its history, the St. Joseph River has always attracted and sustained life. From furs and food to transportation, power, and recreation, the river serves a central role in the lives of those who call its banks home. To this day, its waters provide for native people. In the past, those waters attracted global powers to the region and later, powered the industries that built the cities of today. However, rapid industrialization and population growth took a toll on the river during the 19th and 20th centuries, altering its flow and polluting its waters. Today, however, the river is undergoing an astonishing transformation. Its waters are cleaner, and it serves as a point of pride for its communities, inspiring new development and recreational opportunities.

WNIT tells the story of the St. Joseph River, including the people, history, and life along this storied river from Hillsdale to Lake Michigan. We celebrate how it has shaped the region and continues to be an integral part of our community. We hope this documentary will accelerate the renewed appreciation for the St. Joseph River and inspire people to preserve and cherish the river for future generations.

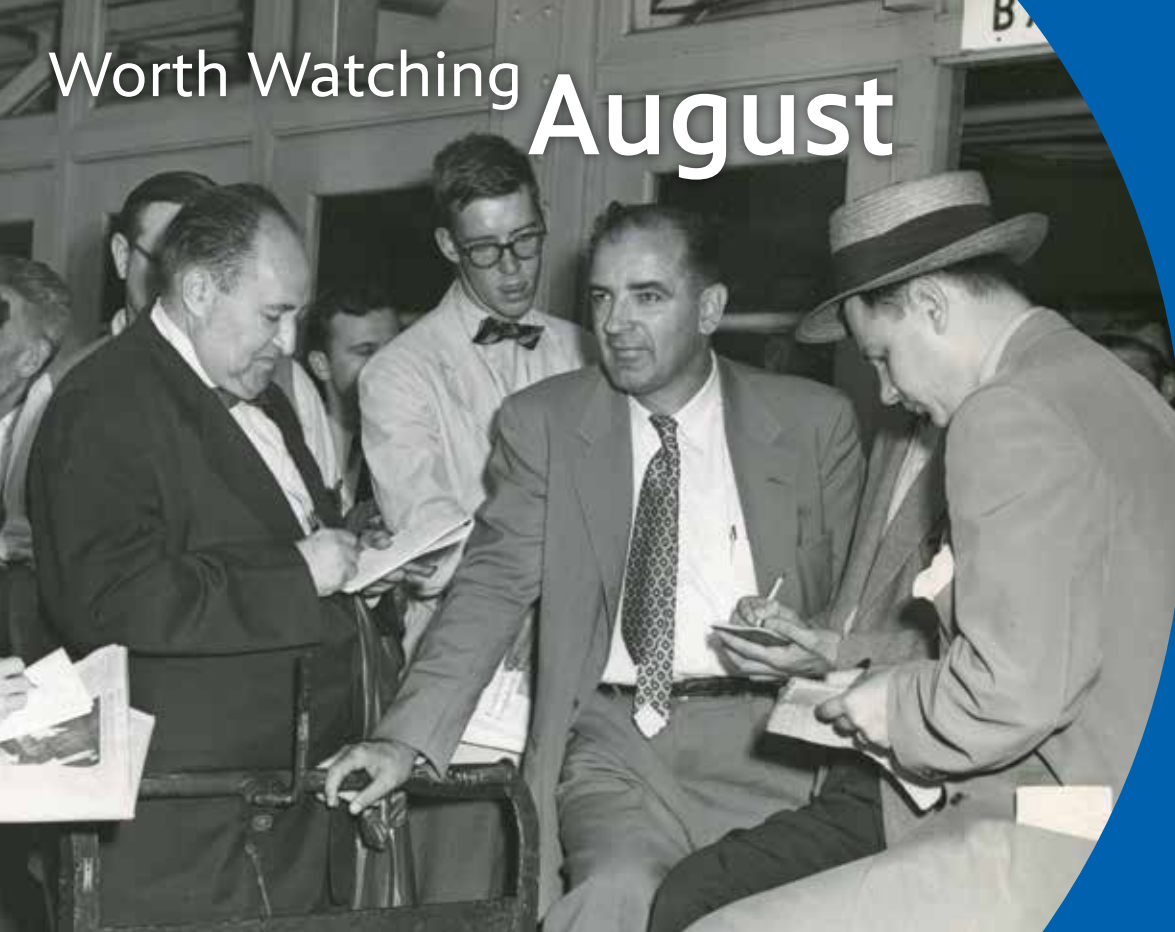

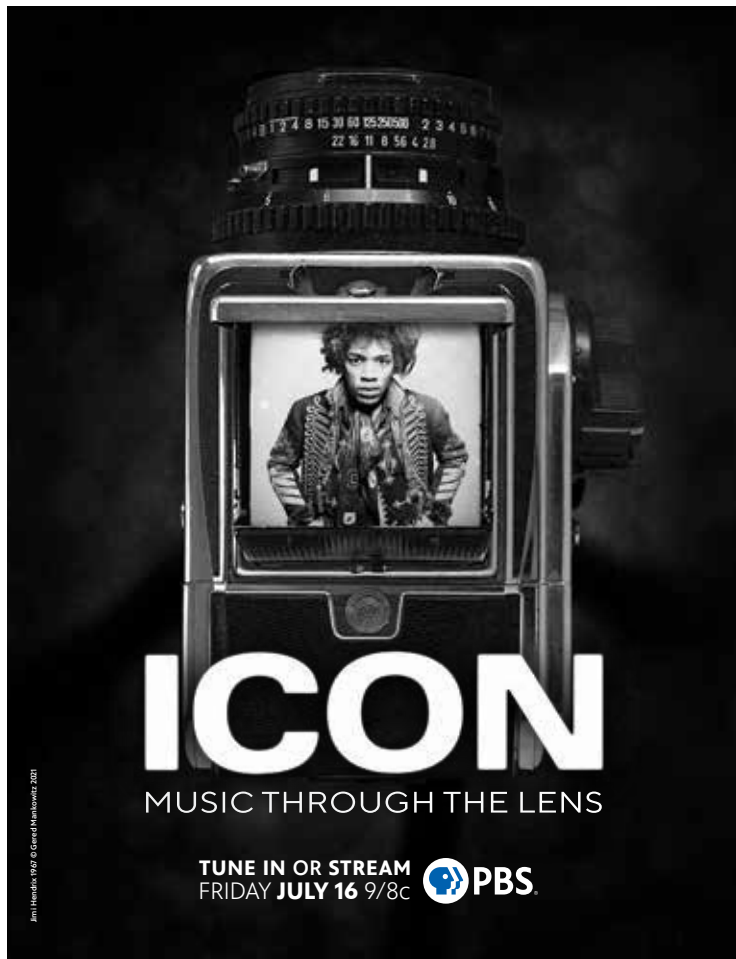

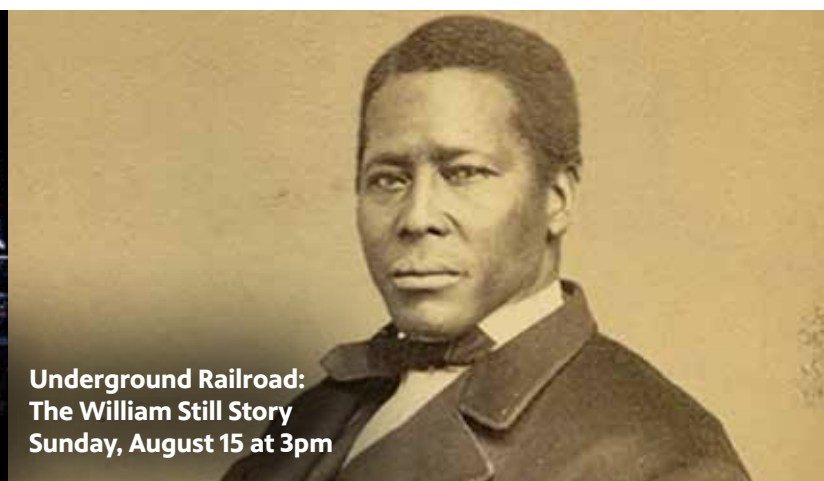
