Its waters are cleaner, and it serves as a point of pride for its communities, inspiring new development and recreational opportunities.

PBS Michiana - WNIT tells the story of the St. Joseph River, including the people, history, and life along this storied river from Hillsdale to Lake Michigan. Celebrate how the St. Joseph River has shaped the region and continues to be an integral part of our community. The hope is that this

documentary will accelerate the renewed appreciation for the St. Joseph River and inspire people to preserve and cherish the river for future generations.

The documentary will include an original score by composer Dr. Marvin Curtis. The score will be available for local symphonies to perform in celebration of the St. Joseph River. WNIT also plans to produce educational materials for in-classroom teaching on the River.

"We are pleased to produce this documentary on our region's greatest natural resource," said WNIT President and General Manager Greg Giczi.
