I'm in a great mood as I write this letter. It's the end of February and March-April mean "spring" to me! While it hasn't been a horrible winter, I'd rather be cutting my lawn than snow blowing my drive.

Offering meaningful local programming is an important "pillar" of our PBS Michiana-WNIT mission. In addition to the six weekly local programs, we strive to feature at least one special local program per month. We produce most of it ourselves but also include productions from trusted local/regional partners.

Coming up each Wednesday at 7:30pm in March, PBS Michiana-WNIT will present a *Women in Leadership* documentary. Our newest will be on March 30th featuring women first responders.

Goshen College offers its documentary *Vital Passage* on Monday, April 18th at 10pm. The story begins with the discovery of a lockbox buried in the downtown Goshen basement of a former Jewish merchant's store. When it is unlocked, a half century of old secrets comes to light.

The University of Notre Dame's College of Science presents for the first time, "The Christmas Lecture: Neuroscience for Everyone, Featuring Greg Gage." Don't let the title scare you, Dr. Gage makes a very engaging presentation. See it Wednesday, April 20th at 10pm, following *NOVA*.

"Arts @ IU-South Bend" continues its monthly presentations in both March and April and the classic movies continue on PBS Michiana-WNIT2. Check your *Planner* magazine for the WNIT1 and WNIT2 times.

I need to squeeze in a couple of shout-outs for a few national programs. *Sanditon* Season 2 premieres Sunday, March 20th...Ken Burns' *Ben Franklin* airs April 4th and 5th...and new episodes of *Finding Your Roots* start April 12th. More great programs are featured in this *Planner* magazine.

We listened as many viewers expressed disappointment when another local station discontinued its weather channel. We recognized that this was an especially important service for cord-cutters, those who only watch their local stations using an antenna. Weather Michiana-WNIT4 on channel 34.4 will offer 24/7 local weather statistics and live radar.

Need an activity for your kids/grandkids. Join us for the grand opening of the very first Nature Cat Trail in the country on April 30th at 10am. It ties lessons from the *Nature Cat* television show to the real world. Details are on the following page.

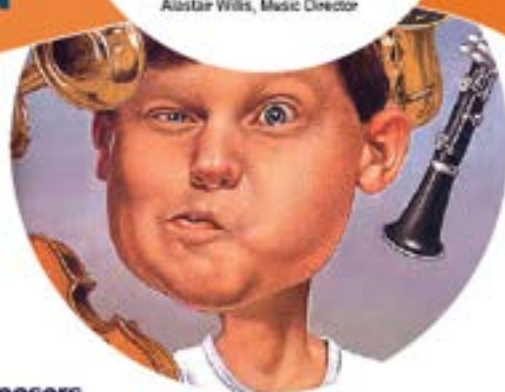
