








A Message from Greg Giczi

President and GM, PBS Michiana - WNIT



Hello PBS Michiana Viewers and Contributors,

Happy New Year! I hope all your holidays were merry and bright. We still have lots to celebrate in January and February, so don't take off the party hats yet!

First, I want to alert you to a significant program change. Beginning the first week in February, we are reducing the amount of children's programming, Mondays to Fridays, on our primary channel, 34.1. We will begin featuring programs for grown-ups beginning at 2pm. We're not reducing our commitment to early childhood learning, but rather adapting to the newer viewing habits of our youngest viewers. Research is showing us that most kids are now "streaming" their shows and heavily using our 24/7 PBS Kids Channel on 34.3. At the same time, adults at that time are looking for more PBS content than what we offer for them on WNIT2, channel 34.2. Remember, this change starts February 6th on 34.1.

I could use this entire PBS Michiana-WNIT *Planner* magazine writing about the next topic. Significant broadcast signal improvements are being introduced by television stations all over the country and soon in Michiana. "NextGen TV" is the next generation of digital broadcasting. For the last 20 years, we have only been in our first generation of digital. This new signal format will offer better and easier to receive pictures, plus other services. It will be possible to integrate "TV" into your streaming menu. If you are currently in the market for a new television, consider purchasing one with NextGen TV already built in. Adaptors will be available for older televisions. We will provide you information along the way, but if you want to learn more, I've found a good source of information at: **www.cnet.com**. Search for NextGen TV articles.

There are always a lot of programs in each edition of your PBS Michiana-WNIT *Planner*. In January, you can look forward to several season premieres including *All Creatures Great and Small, Miss Scarlet and the Duke*, and *Vienna Blood*. There is also an especially good *American Masters* on January 24th at 9pm. Roberta Flack will be featured.

February is Black History Month. The whole month will be sprinkled with special programs including local *Arts @ IUSB: A Celebration of African-American Music,* Monday, February 6th at 10pm and February 12th at 4pm. We will also have an encore of *Legends of Michiana: Virginia and Richmond Calvin,* Thursday, February 6th at 10pm and Sunday, February 12 at 4pm. Of the national programs, I've got *Great Performances: The Magic of Spirituals* on February 24th at 9pm circled on my calendar.

2022 was a good year for PBS Michiana-WNIT! That happened because of your viewership and financial support. I believe we produced some significant local programming, and more is coming in the New Year.

Many of you recognized that inflation is pinching us as well and increased your donations a bit. That was very appreciated. Happy viewing!
