Hello Boosters of PBS Michiana – WNIT!

March and April always feel to me like we are between seasons. We still have a little winter while we get teased by spring. I hope you find plenty to enjoy on our five program services and Passport.

If you watch PBS Michiana-WNIT using an antenna you can see all five of our services grouped together as 34-1-2-3-4-5. But on cable or streaming it gets a little hard to find all our offerings. Some of the streaming services do not carry PBS channels at all. If you have one of those, you can still get PBS Michiana-WNIT by antenna or go to our website and stream directly from there.

It's true that WNIT belongs to you. As a non-profit, we belong to the entire Michiana community, governed by a volunteer board from throughout our region. Our 50-year anniversary comes up next year and we're investing a lot of time in planning for our future, strategizing for the next several years. We're facing changes in technology like NextGen TV and the shift to streaming. There's also a lot more "competition" for your screen time, and your viewing habits have likely changed. I'd like to hear your thoughts for the PBS Michiana-WNIT of the future. What should we be doing to continue serving Michiana in an important way? Just reach out to me by email, ggiczi@wnit.org. I promise that I will share all your input with our board planning committee.

As you look through the pages of this PBS Michiana-WNIT *Planner* magazine, you'll see that we start the month of March conducting our spring membership drive. If you have a friend comment about an outstanding program, say, "I hope you are a member." We return in mid-March with several premieres on Sunday, March 19th. At 8pm on that day, season 12 of *Call the Midwife* begins, at 9pm it's season 3 of *Sanditon* and at 10pm *Marie Antoinette* season 1 premieres. If you can still stay up, *Our Miracle Years* comes on at 11pm.

We will also be featuring some outstanding local programs in March. Among them, the stunning photography of faculty member Susan Moore will be featured on *Arts @ IUSB*, Thursday, March 16th at 8pm (and other dates). Kelly Burgét, one of our *Experience Michiana* hosts, will be dancing her heart out on *Live at Notre Dame: "Uzima,"* on Thursday, March 23rd at 8pm. Then, an episode of our *Women in Leadership* series will be presented Wednesday, March 29th at 7:30pm.

In April, *My Grandparents' War*, which we feature on our cover, premieres on Tuesday, April 11th at 9pm. Other PBS programs of special note would be our *Great Performances* series, every Friday at 8pm, and *Changing Planet*, Wednesday, April 19th at 9pm. Local programs include an organ recital on *Live at Notre Dame*, Thursday, April 6th at 8pm, and a piano concert on *Arts @ IUSB* on Thursday, April 27th at 8pm.

Good stuff! And, you'll find a lot more as you browse through these *Planner* pages. Need to catch up on some programs? That's why we have *Passport* with more programs being added each month. *Passport* is a member benefit for annual gifts of \$60+. My Grandparents' War

**Four-part World War II history-genealogy series
premieres Sundays, April 11-25 on PBS**

Combining key moments in history with compelling personal stories, *My Grandparents' War* is a new four-part series that takes a fascinating journey into the past to understand the extraordinary impact of World War II on the families of four British actors. Helena Bonham Carter (*The Crown*, "Harry Potter" series), Mark Rylance ("Dunkirk," "Bridge of Spies," *Masterpiece: Wolf Hall*), Kristin Scott Thomas ("Darkest Hour," "The English Patient") and Carey Mulligan ("Promising Young Woman," "The Great Gatsby")

each host a one-hour journey into their respective family histories as they travel to historic locations, from the beaches of Dunkirk to the former site of a prisoner-of-war camp in Hong Kong, to retrace their grandparents' footsteps during the conflict that changed their lives forever.
