A Message from Greg Giczi

President and GM, PBS Michiana - WNIT



Hello Viewers and Champions of PBS Michiana-WNIT!

I think it was that period of great weather we had in mid-April that has me all perky! I'm ready to share my usual recommendations on upcoming programs, plus I have some big technology news. Your financial support makes this all possible. Thank you very, very much. Let's start with programming, because that is always the most important thing we do.

We have a new documentary in our *Legends of Michiana* series. On Thursday, May 25th, we'll tell the story of Jeannine Alick, the founder of Alick's Home Medical, her personal generosity, and her advocacy for seniors and those with homebound medical needs. Do you watch the monthly *Arts @ IUSB* series? This month on Thursday, May 4th at 8pm, the program will feature their Jazz Ensemble. We also have a *Live from Notre Dame* presentation on May 18th, at 8pm, with the Notre Dame Children's Choir. Continuing with our May "Arts" theme, the new season of *Great Performances* is on each Friday at 9pm.

June starts with a membership drive from the 2nd through the 11th. Invite a few friends to watch and then ask them to join you supporting PBS Michiana-WNIT. We can always use a few more members – as our budget grows we are able to spend more on programs.

There are so many good programs in June! *Arts @ IUSB* this month teams up with the Fiscoff National Chamber Music Association to present the "Lift Every Voice Soiree." That's at 8pm on June 22nd. Keeping with the "Juneteenth" theme, we will be presenting a documentary produced by Goshen College, *Goshen: A Sundown Town's Transformation*. The first broadcast will be on Tuesday, June 20th at 9pm. It's amazing the interesting things you learn on public television! And, our eighth program in our *Women in Leadership* series will be broadcast on Wednesday, June 28th at 7:30pm. Kudos, again, to Jerry Hammes, for funding that series. This is a terrific series of PBS Michiana original programs describing women's career pathways.

Now for a little bit of technology. Don't let your eyes glaze over. Remember about 20 years ago when we started switching from "analog" television to "digital?" It brought about better-quality pictures and the ability to have more than one program stream in a "channel." We are about to begin introducing a new generation of digital technology. It will be phased in over a 3+ year period, so no need to panic. It's called NextGen TV and it's already in over 70 other regions. We will be getting NextGen TV starting in mid-June. The Michiana area will be the second region in Indiana to have it, even before Chicago. Your current TV will continue to work just fine, but if you are shopping for a new one, consider getting one that is NextGen TV ready, so you will be set for the future. We will have a lot more on this in our July-August Planner.

Thursday, May 18th, is our annual "Day of Giving." On this day, some special friends of PBS Michiana-WNIT contribute to create a "challenge fund." For every extra dollar you contribute they match it. You give \$100 and they give \$100, like that. We have some important projects in the works, and the extra funding would be greatly appreciated. Thank you!






