A Message from Greg Giczi

President and GM, PBS Michiana - WNIT



Hi there, PBS Michiana-WNIT Owners,

Welcome to our September-October *Planner* magazine! I know you know WNIT belongs to you, but I suspect many of our viewers do not. Michiana Public Broadcasting Corporation is the non-profit entity which operates PBS Michiana-WNIT. We are a “community-owned” station governed by a *volunteer* group of directors. Everything we do is on your behalf. Any of our profits (ha!) benefit our programming and operations. Our business model is unlike any other local media organization. We are so confident in our product (our programming) that we give it away for free and trust our viewers to recognize that quality and support us with a donation appropriate to their means. Thank you for doing that for nearly 50 years.

2024 is our anniversary year of that 50-year milestone. You’ll be hearing a lot more about that in coming months. We plan to have celebration events in several communities so we can include as many of you as possible. We’re also working on a documentary about our history and will be announcing plans to create additional local programming.

The seasons are changing and a traditional time for the introduction of new programming. September will bring two original local documentaries to PBS Michiana-WNIT. On Thursday, September 7th at 8pm, Carmi and Chris Murphy will be the focus of our next *Legends of Michiana Series*. Later in the month, on Thursday the 28th, also at 8pm, I believe you will want to watch *Pokagon Band of Potawatomi: A Song for Everything*. We started working on this documentary in 2020 when COVID-19 got in the way. Our story of the Pokagon Band has taken us beyond Michiana to Canada and New Mexico.

September starts with a big event. On Friday, September 1st, we will re-air Joni Mitchell’s Library of Congress Award special. Several PBS programs also premiere in September. Sunday, the 3rd, all three of these programs have their season premiere: *Professor T* season 2, *Unforgotten* season 5, and *Van Der Valk* season 3. *Sunday Night Football* getting in the way and you don’t have control of the TV? That’s why we have Passport! Make sure you are signed up for this member service.

I grew up on the west side of South Bend. When our family would travel to Lake Michigan or Chicago we would take Western Avenue. We would pass a farm which had a herd of buffalo. It was quite a sight for a young boy to see these big, hairy animals and to later learn in school of their place in our national history.

American Buffalo is our upcoming Ken Burns documentary, and it premieres October 16th and 17th.

There are more PBS premieres on Sundays in October starting on the 15th: *Hotel Portofino* season 2, *World on Fire* season 2, and *Annika*. A must-see is *Spy in the Ocean* on Wednesday, October 25th. *American Experience* brings back some musical memories on Tuesday, October 30th, with “The War on Disco.” Living through that era, I didn’t realize that disco was that polarizing.

Thank you for your on-going viewership and financial support of PBS Michiana-WNIT. We all have a stake in what we do because we are all PBS Michiana’s owners.

Jonathan Dely: Live in Concert with his All-Star Jazz Band Friday, Sept. 8, 7 p.m.



THE AMERICAN BUFFALO



A FILM BY KEN BURNS

The American Buffalo, a new two-part, four-hour series, takes viewers on a journey through more than 10,000 years of North American history and across some of the continent's most iconic landscapes, tracing the animal's evolution, its significance to the Indigenous people and landscape of the Great Plains, its near extinction, and the efforts to bring the magnificent mammals back from the brink.

For thousands of generations, buffalo (species *bison bison*) have evolved alongside Indigenous people who relied on them for food and shelter, and, in exchange for killing them, revered the animal. The stories of Native people anchor the series, including the Kiowa, Comanche, and Cheyenne of the Southern Plains; the Lakota, Salish, Kootenai, Mandan-Hidatsa, and Blackfeet from the Northern Plains; and others.

Numbering an estimated 30 million in the early 1800s, the herds began declining for a variety of reasons, including the lucrative buffalo robe trade, the steady westward settlement of an expanding United States, diseases introduced by domestic cattle, and drought. But the arrival of the railroads in the early 1870s, and a new demand for buffalo hides to be used in the belts driving industrial machines back East, brought thousands of hide hunters to the Great Plains. In just over a decade the number of bison collapsed from 12-15 million to fewer than a thousand, representing one of the most dramatic examples of our ability to destroy the natural world. By 1900, the American buffalo teetered on the brink of disappearing forever, and Native people of the Plains entered one of the most traumatic moments of their existence.




