I was watching a station other than PBS Michiana-WNIT on February 11th. That was Super Bowl Sunday and I watched the game on a NextGen TV channel. The pictures were stunning, a cut above high definition. Next Gen TV is the new broadcast technology that is to eventually replace our current HD standard. PBS Michiana-WNIT's primary channel is already broadcasting in this new format. It takes the spectacular photography in programs like *Nature* to whole new level. Just dazzling!

We've got great programs to go along with those great looking pictures.
