Yes! I am referring to you. Thank you for caring enough about the service PBS Michiana-WNIT provides this community that you are not only an avid viewer, but a financial investor. When I write this letter for our *Planner* magazine, I am focused on one person, you.

Oh, the seasons are changing, footballs are in the air! Some of our viewers will watch a little less PBS during the fall and others a lot more as they seek an intelligent refuge from the proliferation of sports on television. I'm happy that we can provide a great alternative.

October is packed with captivating programming you won't want to miss! Tune in every Friday at 8PM for *Voces American Historia*, a series that delves into the rich and diverse stories of Latinx communities. On Thursday, October 10, we'll re-air the powerful local documentary: *Pokagon Band of Potawatomi: A Song for Everything* at 8PM, followed by *Fighting Indians* at 9PM, which explores the resilience and heritage of Native American tribes. On Thursday, October 17 at 8PM, don't miss the local Indiana documentary *The Girl with the Yellow Scarf*, offering a heartfelt look at a Martinsville, Indiana 1968 civil rights case.

We continue celebrating our 50<sup>th</sup> year of broadcasting and building toward our next 50. I hope you might consider a special gift for this milestone. We are raising additional funds for 1) equipment replacement, 2) expansion of our educational outreach services, 3) creation of additional local programming, and 4) general operations. 

Filmed in one of the most dynamic locations on the African continent, *Big Cats 24/7* captures the big cats' battle to survive through dramatic changes within their families and their home. An elite camera team including wildlife cinematographers Gordon Buchanan, Vianet Djenguet and Anna Dimitriadis, led by Brad Bestelink and his local camera team, documents the dramatic lives of individual lions, cheetahs and leopards for six months over two extreme seasons. This raw and unfiltered observational wildlife series shows their fight to survive in an increasingly challenging world. From unprecedented wildfire to floods and extreme drought, the African cats and the *Big Cats 24/7* camera crew are tested to their limits.



Mike joined WNIT as Engineering Supervisor in August 1997 after spending 24 years as an engineer and engineering supervisor at WSBT Radio and Television, along with running his own two-way radio installation and repair business and other consulting work. Mike's many accomplishments at WNIT include: the design and construction of WNIT's digital transmitter plant in 2003 and our conversion to digital broadcasting; installation of the diesel backup generator for our transmitter site in 2004; recovering from our devastating office fire in 2009; designing and building the technical plant in our new South Bend location in 2009-10 and seamlessly moving our operation without loss of air time; expanding our transmitter to increase our signal strength in 2011; overseeing construction of a new TV transmitter in 2019; rebuilding our studio infrastructure in 2019 to replace our video server and add the PBS Kid's Channel on 34.3; and many others over 27 years. Mike has come up with many imaginative, out-ofthe-box fixes over the years to keep us on the air while under the budget constraints of public broadcasting.

Mike cut back to part-time the first of this year, but is still a part of the WNIT Engineering team and continues to maintain our transmitter plant and help out with other projects as needed.
