Dear Members,

When I first sat at this desk as President and General Manager 6 months ago, I had no idea what the next half year would bring. In that time, Indiana cut public media from its budget, and as of this writing, the country is threatening to do the same. Facing a sudden and immediate loss of up to 30% of our budget has been difficult, to say the least. I've worked long hours. I've stressed. I probably haven't been as attentive to my children as I should be.

But it's my kids, and all the kids like them—the toddlers who are learning what it means to have big feelings, the preschoolers who want to learn to read, the little girls who love to make potions and slime and want to learn more about science like my daughter, the little boys who want to explore and love animals like my son—it's those kids that will lose the most if we give up the fight for public media.

I have so many stats about the benefits of PBS programming. I can tell you stories of our viewers, right here in southwestern Michigan and northern Indiana, who learned English with Big Bird, because the dialogue used on *Sesame Street* is specifically designed for early language learners. Or older adults who love to watch *Lawrence Welk* because they remember watching it with their parents. I could tell you that PBS is a crucial part of the emergency alert system and keeps our rural neighbors safe when other systems can't reach them in a weather crisis. Or that *SuperWhy!* has been proven to increase standardized testing scores. Or that our station has proudly carried the mantle of community storytelling so that everyone can have their voice heard and their story told. If you ever need to be convinced of the value and power of public media, I can trot all those out.

But more importantly, today I want to tell you: we have done it all for you. Our neighbors, our viewers, our friends. WNIT has spent 51 years committed to this community, a vital piece of the public trust. When our children haven't been able to attend preschool, we've said, we've got you. When our senior citizens have been aging and gotten less mobile but still want to see live music, we've been there. When someone has wanted to see themselves represented on screen, we've showed up. When families have wanted to see documentaries that inspire learning and are safe for all ages, we've welcomed them in.

PBS Michiana – WNIT is for everyone. Our focus isn't ratings or airtime value or audience numbers. Our focus has always been bringing you the best, highest quality programming that makes your life, your community, and your world better. And we've stayed free for everyone—all you need is an antenna.

We don't plan to go anywhere. Wherever the next few months are taking us, our plan to be here, serving you. You are the heart of everything we do, and we can't thank you enough for standing with us as we weather this storm. I don't know what the other side will bring, but I do know that we're committed to you. I'm so glad to know you're there with us—just as we are there for you.

Here's to the last 51 years, and to 51 more.

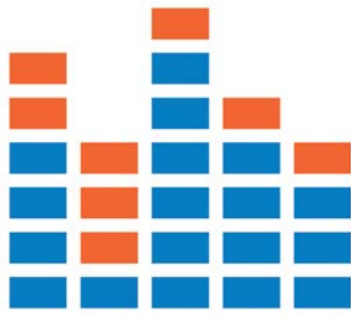

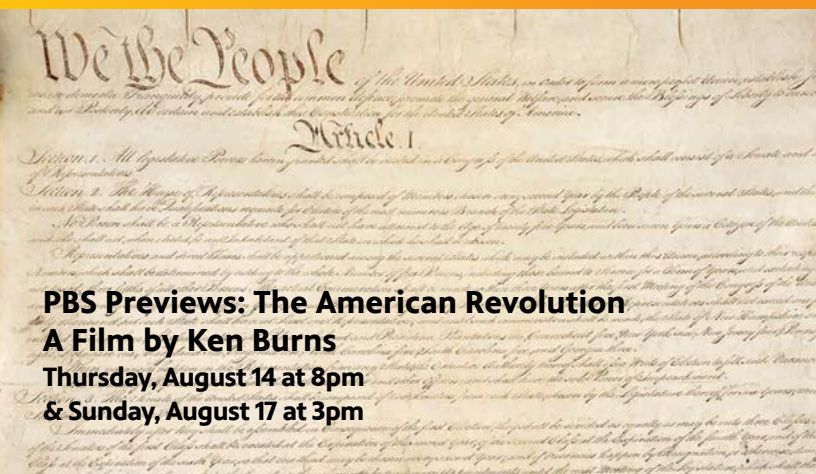
