

This change is just one of many steps we're taking to keep PBS Michiana – WNIT strong in challenging times, but please know that we aren't going anywhere. We're still here, providing education, arts and culture, lifelong learning, and community connection.

Thank you for standing by us. This community built us, and we remain committed to serving you. After all, PBS Michiana – WNIT has always belonged to you.
