




The American Revolution, a new six-part, 12-hour documentary series, examines how America's founding turned the world upside-down.

Thirteen British colonies on the Atlantic Coast rose in rebellion, won their independence, and established a new form of government that radically reshaped the continent and inspired centuries of democratic movements around the globe.

The Revolution began a movement for people around the world to imagine new and better futures for themselves, their nations, and for humanity. It declared American independence with promises that we continue to strive for. The American Revolution opened the door to advance civil liberties and human rights, and it asked questions that we are still trying to answer today.

The American Revolution premieres Sunday, November 16th at 8/7c.





A More Perfect Union examines how we think about America's founding and how the ideas and values articulated 250 years ago remain relevant to conversations about governance today. It features Ken Burns in conversation with Jeffrey Rosen, Melody Barnes and Yuval Levin, among others. The discussion explores essential themes such as liberty, equality, democracy, separation of powers, and civil rights.

At a time of profound political polarization, this special aims to inspire and unite Americans through a renewed civic conversation rooted in the founding principles of the Declaration of Independence, the Constitution, and the American idea.






