A note from the *Education Counts* producer, Nathan Krebs:

Education Counts is shifting to create more digital-exclusive content that will reach new audiences. People can find this content on our Facebook, Instagram, YouTube, and TikTok channels.

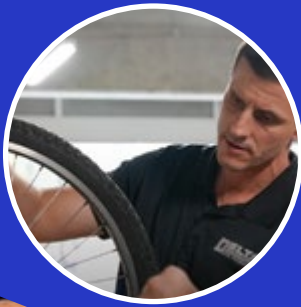

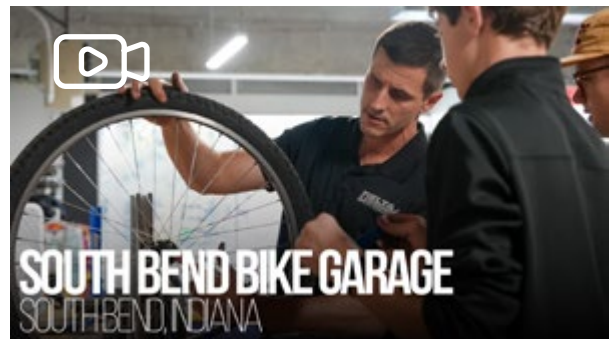

Delivering the Programs You Love

In this month's article we are exploring the roles that our Programming, Traffic, Master Control, and Engineering team play in the delivery of broadcast and streaming programs. Thank you to our team for a job well done!



The Ecosystem of PBS

Public television is a decentralized network of independent organizations working together. PBS is a membership organization made up of more than 330 stations. They provide national programming, distribution, and technical services while individual stations remain independently operated and responsible for their local programming and services.

Programs come from many sources, including PBS member stations, independent producers, international partners, and organizations. This collaborative structure is one reason PBS can offer such a wide range of documentaries, dramas, news, science, history, arts, and children's programming.

PBS makes much of this programming available to stations through the National Program Service (NPS), PBS Plus, and other distribution services. PBS Distribution, a joint venture of PBS and GBH (Boston), extends public media content to streaming services, digital platforms, broadcast, and physical media, while distributors such as American Public Television provide additional programming to local stations.

Stations then combine these national and independently acquired programs with their own local content to create schedules for their communities. Today, viewers can experience that programming not only through traditional linear-style broadcast television, but also through non-linear streaming (live and on-demand).

The Ecosystem of PBS Michiana – WNIT

The PBS Michiana – WNIT production team creates programs that tell stories about the people, places, ideas, and issues of our region. (We will explore our production department more in depth next month).

Once a local production has been recorded and edited, the completed program is transferred into the station's broadcast workflow. The appropriate Traffic and Master Control team members are notified when the program is in the server and ready for scheduling and broadcast. WNIT also makes programming available through its website, on-demand video services, the PBS app, Passport, YouTube, and other digital platforms.



The Programming Service

The Programming Service (TPS) is an independent external support organization for public television. TPS works with PBS and departments at WNIT to develop the station's programming schedule.

Using information from PBS, WNIT's local production department, traffic, and other areas of the station, TPS selects programs and builds the broadcast calendar. Scheduling is typically planned several months in advance, while individual schedules are refined as programming information becomes available. TPS also considers audience information, ratings, local viewing patterns, programming rights, and other factors when developing schedules. During fundraising periods, TPS works with the development manager to plan schedules that support the station's membership and campaign efforts. TPS also provides guidance on program acquisitions and helps coordinate programming rights and related considerations.

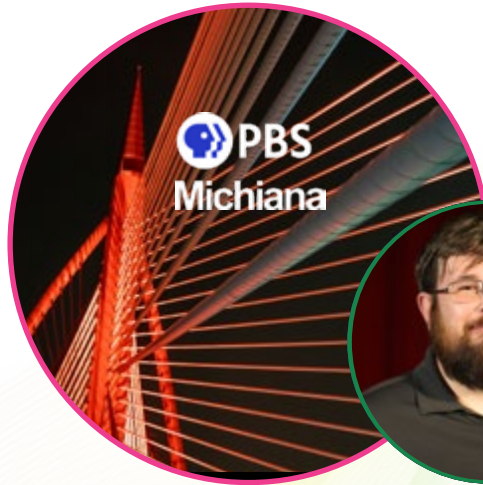

Traffic

Traffic takes the programming schedule and prepares the detailed broadcast log. This includes scheduling underwriting announcements, promotional spots, program elements, and other material that needs to air between programs. Traffic also coordinates the scheduling and documentation of required broadcast tests and alerts, maintains records of what has aired, and prepares reports used by various departments. Traffic also helps ensure that required regulatory and public-file documentation is completed and maintained in accordance with FCC requirements.

Engineering

Engineering keeps the station's technical infrastructure operating safely and reliably. That work can range from cybersecurity to maintaining transmitters and broadcast equipment to repairing or replacing hardware and supporting the technology used throughout the building. Engineering is responsible for critical transmission infrastructure, including the microwave link between the studio and transmitter.

Master Control

Master Control is responsible for monitoring the station's broadcast and making sure programming reaches viewers as scheduled and at the appropriate technical quality. Master Control monitors the on-air signal, manages the Emergency Alert System, and responds when something goes wrong. Master Control works to keep the station on the air.

BJ and Becky sent us some gorgeous photos of the two of them from over the 20+ years they have been at WNIT. BJ moved to work with The Programming Service, but still works closely with us.

Trent gave us a tour through the photos below.



"This is our equipment room that we call the 'tech plant.' This includes hardware that receives live feeds, plays out recorded shows and inserts logos and legal ID's. This is considered the heart of the technical operations at WNIT."



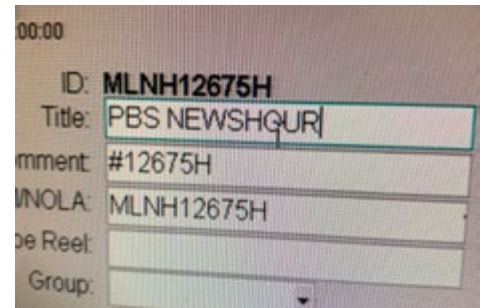
"Master Control: this is where we monitor incoming and the outgoing feeds that go to the transmitter by the U.S. 20 bypass. The area that our tower is located at is called "radio tower hill." This is a convenient spot due to the elevation of the ground to reach as many households as possible. The main job for Master Control is to keep us on the air with no extended periods of black and to quality check our programming and over the air signal."



"This is production control. Sometimes we may have shows that go directly from the studio to air. This area is where a production director will mix the shots from the studio and then send it as a live feed to master control. We did this a lot with live pledges in the past."



"This is an automation server screen where we setup records that PBS will feed us at a later time."



"This is a server code we use in our automation server to label records that must air at a later time."

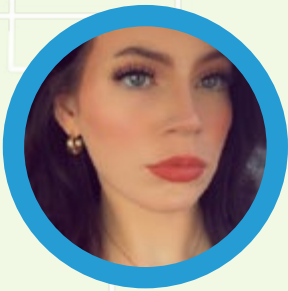

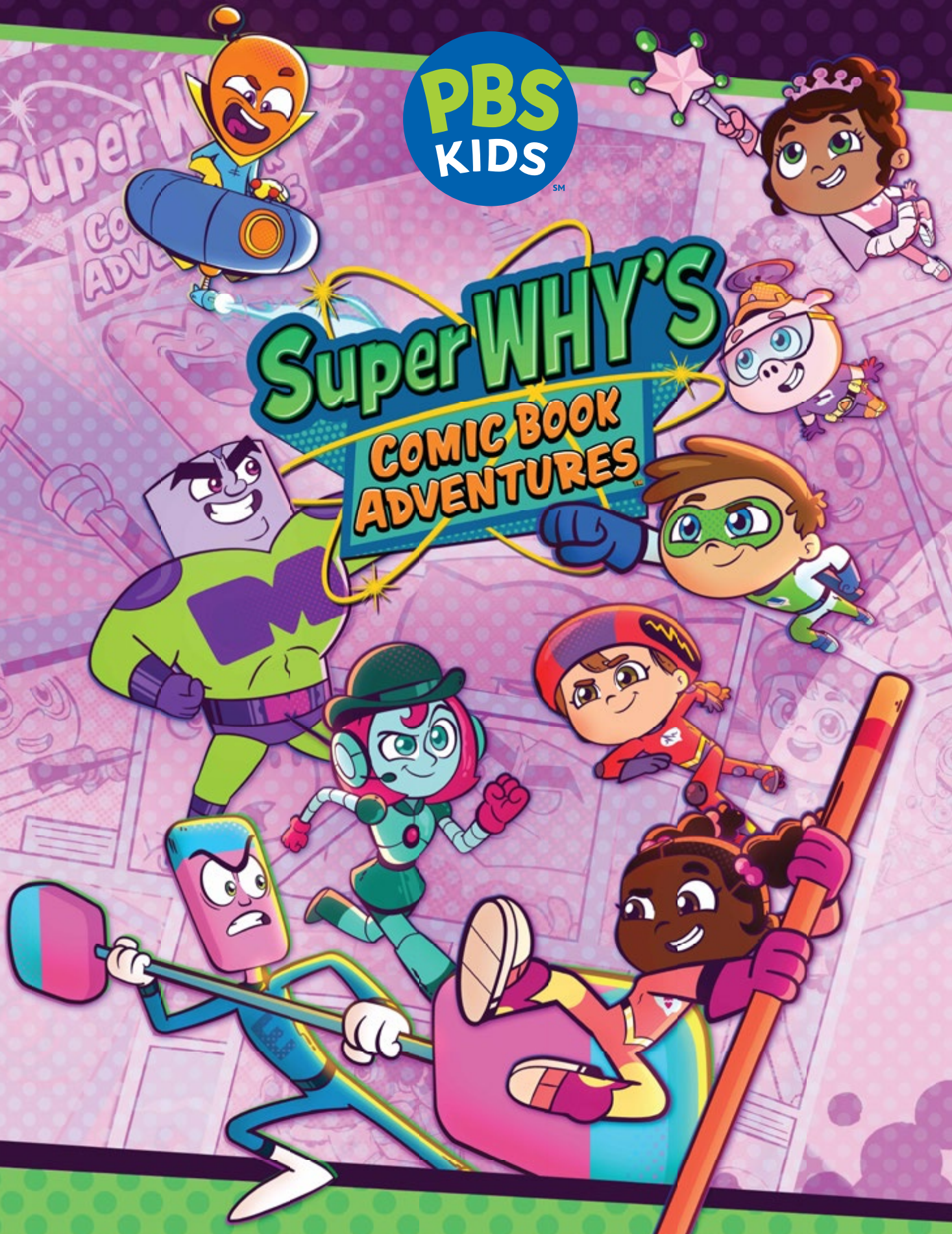
