Masterpiece: Victoria Returns to WNIT Public Television

Jenna Coleman returns for a new season as the young queen who wants it all — romance, power, an heir, and personal freedom — on *Victoria*, *Season 2*, airing in seven episodes that premiere January 14 on MASTERPIECE.




Thomas J. Borger March 22, 1948 - November 7, 2017


